### End of term message & Modernisation Update

After a very short (but very busy) half term, the children are off school next week for a well earned rest. We will return to school on Monday 2<sup>nd</sup> June for the final half term of the year... another very busy one with lots going on, so please check the 'events and dates' section at the end of the newsletter for diary markers.

I also have some very important news to share regarding the future of Wood Memorial, and schools within the area.

Many of you will remember filling in the 'Early Engagement' document approximately 18 months ago, proposing different options for re-structuring schools within the Saltney area. Following this, Flintshire County Council posted a press release earlier this year, proposing that Wood Memorial C.P. School and Saltney Ferry C.P. School are amalgamated into one newly built school building. The new school would be built on Wood Memorial's school field.

The next stage of this process, is a public consultation, whereby you have the opportunity to share your views with the council regarding the plans. The public consultation will go live on June 3<sup>rd</sup> and run till July 18<sup>th</sup>. I will share all of the information with parents, families and the wider community once they are available. I will also look to hold a drop-in café session to provide an opportunity to talk through the document and ask any questions.

We want as many people as possible to respond to the consultation (whether affiliated to the schools or not) as this will impact everyone living in the area, so please share widely once it is available.

# Again, this is YOUR chance to share how you feel about what is being proposed and an opportunity to be heard, so please take it.

As always, thank you for your support this term – we really do appreciate it. Have a lovely week off and we look forward to seing the children back at Woody on Monday 2<sup>nd</sup> June.

### Uniform and P.E. Kit

As we are reaching the middle point of the summer term, we have a number of events and trips out, and a lot of visitors coming into school.
