## Uniform and P.E. Kit

As we are reaching the middle point of the summer term, we have a number of events and trips out, and a lot of visitors coming into school. Whenever we go out from school (or have visitors here), we are very proud representatives of Wood Memorial - our uniform is an important part of that identity.

We have noticed that lots of children are not currently wearing the correct uniform. We appreciate that we are coming to the end of the school year and families may wish to wait until September to purchase new uniform. Football shirts should not be worn to school for P.E. days at any point.

We have also seen an increase in children wearing different jewellery for school at the moment including chains, bracelets and dangly earrings. This is not part of our uniform policy and, more importantly, poses a health and safety concern. This can lead to serious accidents as children play and take part in P.E. sessions – we have dealt with one such incident this week.

We would really appreciate your support in ensuring that children wear the appropriate uniform for school every day, including on P.E. days.
