School Transport

- Free school transport is normally only provided to the nearest suitable secondary school where the distance is more than 3 miles, subject to the Council's policy.
- If, as a result of your school preference, your child attends a school that is not the nearest suitable school recognised by Flintshire County Council, you will be responsible for all transport costs and arrangements.
- Do not base your school preference on the availability of public transport, as routes and capacity are not guaranteed.
